Super Friday Technology Policy

- Students are not allowed to use internet-capable tablets, laptops or phones at Super Fridays, unless they are required to use it for a class. This includes morning time before classes, snack time, and any time waiting on campus after classes, unless they are being supervised by their parent. Devices MUST remain in the student's bag and turned off at all times when not being used for a class.
- Students using a laptop or phone with internet access for a class (for example, programming, etc) are NOT allowed to open any website or app other than the ones directed by the teacher.
- Any student violating these rules will receive consequences as follows:
 - 1st offense- Student sent to Mrs. Pruyn, parents called, device confiscated until parent picks it up at the end of the day.
 - 2nd offense- Student sent to Mrs. Pruyn, parent called, device confiscated until parent picks it up at the end of the day, 1 week suspension from Super Fridays.
 - 3rd offense- Student will not be able to return to Super Fridays for the remainder of the semester.
